Sharil 先生在马来西亚通信多媒体委员会负责领导制定新的监管政策，例如制定新的频率分配模式 (特别是 3G 频率分配)、新的宽带行动计划，以及缩小数字鸿沟方面的网络建设项目。他曾担任马来西亚“多媒体超级走廊” (MSC) 计划的顾问工作，特别是参与了 7 个初期旗舰项目中的两个。

在就职马来西亚通信多媒体委员会之前，Sharil 先生是一个律师，专门从事立法工作。

Sharil 先生与 ICANN 等其他互联网领域方面的国际组织合作密切，担任 ICANN 政府咨询委员会 (GAC) 主席，同时也是 ICANN 董事会成员。

Sharil 先生还担任马来西亚与世界贸易组织 (WTO) 有关电信、计算机和邮政事务的主要谈判代表。他积极参与 ITU、UNDP、APT 等的一些国际活动。

Sharil 先生拥有英国威尔士阿伯斯威大学法学学位，并且拥有英国英格兰和威尔士高等法院辩护律师资格。

Sharil joined BinaFikir Sdn Bhd in April 2006 as an Executive Director. Prior to this, Sharil was the Senior Adviser in the Office of the Chairman, the Malaysian Communications and Multimedia Commission ('MCMC'), a regulator for the converged communications and multimedia sector in Malaysia.

Whilst at MCMC, Sharil was responsible for leading new development initiatives such as the introduction of a new mode of granting spectrum (in particular, 3G) to companies in Malaysia, broadband initiatives and capacity building programmes on bridging the digital divide in the communications and multimedia sector. He was also involved in advising multi-national clients in relation to their participation in the Multimedia Super Corridor ('MSC') Projects and was especially involved in 2 out of the 7 initial MSC Flagship Projects in Malaysia.

Prior to MCMC, Sharil was an attorney specialising in construction law and privatisation of utilities before moving on to communications, multimedia and e-commerce issues.

Sharil has also worked closely with other international organisations in the Internet field such as the Internet Corporation of Assigned Names and Numbers ('ICANN'), where he is currently the Chairman of the Government Advisory Committee ('GAC'), and a member of ICANN's Board of Directors.

Sharil was also one of the lead negotiators for Malaysia in the World Trade Organisation ('WTO') for the telecommunications sector, computer-related services and postal and courier sector. He also has been actively involved in numerous initiatives in the international arena such as the International Telecommunications Union ('ITU'), the World Bank, United Nations Development Program ('UNDP'), Asia Pacific Telecommunity ('APT') and various other international agencies.

Sharil holds an LLB (Hons) from the University College of Wales, Aberystwyth and qualified as a Barrister from Gray's Inn, England and Wales (UK).
