Robert Shaw is the senior advisor to the ITU Secretary-General on Internet strategy and policy issues. As a senior staff member in the ITU Strategy and Policy Unit in the Office of the Secretary-General, he is responsible for identifying emerging technical, policy and regulatory issues in the information and communications technology environment and analyzing their impact on the activities of the International Telecommunication Union (ITU).

Mr. Shaw has a Masters Degree in Telecommunications from the Technical University of Delft, The Netherlands and began his career at the ITU over 20 years ago. During that period he has represented ITU in numerous national, regional and global forums and activities. He has authored and presented numerous papers at conferences around the world.

During the last two years, Mr. Shaw has been involved extensively in the preparation and follow-up activities to the first phase of the World Summit on the Information Society (WSIS), held in Geneva, Switzerland in December 2003, under the high patronage of the UN Secretary-General. The second phase of WSIS will be held in Tunis in 2005.
