Dr. Thaweesak Koanantakool received his Bachelor degree and Ph.D. in Electrical Engineering from Imperial College in 1975 and 1980 respectively. He joined Prince of Songkla University in 1981 and Thammasat University in 1983. His research interests are in the field of digital communication, natural language processing and software. In 1994 he was appointed as Deputy Director of National Electronics and Computer Technology Center (NECTEC) and led the project ThaiSarn, the first Internet in Thailand, and drafted the Thai Language Standard on Computers. During 1998 -2006 he was appointed director of NECTEC and the executive secretary to the National IT Committee, the body that developed the National IT Policies and the National ICT Master Plan for Thailand. At present, He is a Vice President of NSTDA.
