
At the TOT Academy Hotel, internet services are available at the hotel lobby. Also, Wi-Fi card can be purchased for in room use during your stay.

#### Time


The time in Bangkok is 7.00 ahead of Greenwich Mean Time (+7.00 GMT).

#### Electricity

The electric current is 220 volt AC throughout the country.

#### Power Plug

For Thailand, the picture/diagram shows the type of main power plug used in Thailand so participants can bring the right adaptor for their electrical appliances. This plug and receptacle are technically known as NEMA 5-15 (North American 15 A/125 V grounded).



#### Currency

The currency exchange is 1\$ USD is approximately 34 baht

#### Business Hours

Government and business offices are open from 8.30:00 to 16:30 hours, Monday to Friday. Bank opens Monday to Friday from 9.00-15.30 hrs while the department stores open daily from 10.00-20.00 hrs.
