Abstract

The title of the presentation is Overview of changes in the International IP interconnection ecosystem. The presentation describes how international interconnection arrangements have evolved in response to changes in the Internet over the past decade. The focus is on the role of Internet Exchange Points (IXPs) to localize traffic and increase the efficiency of the Internet, as countries with successful IXPs have developed critical mass and begun to host traffic and content for other countries. We highlight successful case studies and the impact of the IXPs on international traffic flows.
