- Consists of 6 programmes, Regional & Special initiatives, 2 Activities

Six ITU-D Programmes

- Regulatory Reforms
- > Network & Infrastructure Dev.
- > E-strategies and ICT applications
- Economics, Finance including costs and tariffs
- > Human Resources Development
- Emergency Telecomms and LDCs
