Background of Samoa



- Samoa lies between 13 & 15 degrees south & 171 and 173 degrees west
- Located half way between Hawaii & NZ
- Land area- 2841 sq.km
- Population – 180,000 est.

OVERVIEW OF TELECOM AND IT

- Growth is increasing
- New Corporation - setup in late 1990s
- National ICT Strategic Plan 2004-2009
 - launched August 2004
 - School net program setup
 - Computer Training programs for grass-root level
- Two mobile services launched:
 - late 2006 and early 2007
 - 40% increase from 2001
- Land line – 21% increase from 2001
- IT user is accelerating



DATA COLLECTION & PRACTICES

- Each business organisation is collecting its own data for its own use
- Statistics Department collects only the following items from its Population Census: TV, internet line, computer, radio, mobile phones, TV (ownership)

Methods of Data collection

- Surveys
- Online questionnaire
- Arranged visits
- Population Census



CHALLENGES

- Response rate is poor esp. questionnaires sent to Businesses
- Several follow up is needed
- Confidentiality of business data
- Statistical Act never enforced when collected data during surveys and census.
- People are willing to partake when there is something in return expected.

POSSIBLE SOLUTIONS

- A well trained and experienced staff/surveyor will be able to deal with these issues
- Statistical Act to review and enforce
- Conduct Public awareness programs
- Collaboration with other organisations is required to encourage and improve
- Statistics Department to include ICT data in its scope of statistics to compile
