On behalf of International Telecommunication Union (ITU) and its partners, APT and UNESCAP, we would like to invite you to nominate participants for the joint APT-*ITU-UNESCAP Capacity Building Workshop on Information Society Statistics: Infrastructure and Household Indicators*, which will take place on 6-8 November 2007 in Bangkok, Thailand.

The workshop will build upon the results of the meeting conducted in the 2006 in the region on the same subject. It will discuss definitions, collection methodologies and data collection issues both for infrastructure indicators and household ICT statistics, as well as other ICT indicators. Our endeavor is to make the programme interactive through your support and active participation. The draft agenda is enclosed. The workshop will be conducted in English only. Electronic contributions to the meeting on country experiences are solicited.
