# ITU statistical work

---

## WTDC06 (Rev.Doha): Resolution 8

- **Collection** and **dissemination** of telecom/ICT statistics (infrastructure and access, ICT households)
- **Setting standards** (definitions, manuals)
- **Analysis** (global, regional, thematic)
- **Cooperation** (UNSD, MDG, Partnership on Measuring ICT for Development, etc.)
- **Technical assistance** (NSOs, regulators/ministries)

## 1. Wealth of information/statistics

Data collection and dissemination tool

- The ICT "eye" , a unified system that compiles all databases of the ITU Development Bureau that enables users to track the development and use of ICTs, and measures efforts to build the information society
- A user-friendly website that provides information including ICT indicators and statistics, regulatory and policy profiles, national tariff policies, operator information, financial and scientific institutions.
- Country profiles and indicator reports

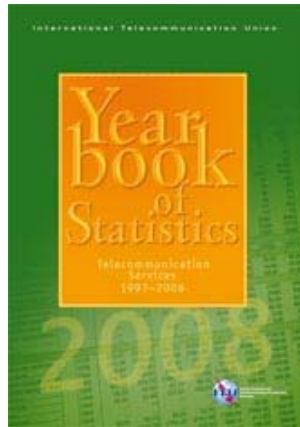
