- Collection and dissemination of telecom/ICT statistics (infrastructure and access, ICT households)


Data collection and dissemination tool








- Topics to be addressed:
 - ICT household statistics (including a presentation of the ITU Household Manual)
 - Revisions and additions to indicators included in the ITU Telecommunication/ICT Indicators Handbook
 - Benchmarking information society developments (including a presentation of the ITU ICT Development Index)
 - International data collection and dissemination
 - Measuring the impact of telecommunication development on the creation of employment



It is important that:

- Countries use internationally agreed indicators and manuals in collecting ICT statistics for comparability of results
- Countries submit timely (telecom/ICT) data through ITU statistics questionnaires
- Countries attend telecom/ICT statistics meetings, workshops, trainings
