

CALL FOR PARTNERS FOR NETWORK PLANNING TOOLS

The Telecommunication Development Bureau (BDT) of the International Telecommunication Union (ITU) is interested in using Planning Tools for assisting developing countries for Network Planning.

The BDT has already negotiated partnership agreements with different companies for using some planning Tools (Broadband access, Trunk, Signalling, Switching, etc.).

These agreements allow ITU using such Tools at privileged conditions: Free use for training and trials, privileged conditions for planning the network for developing countries.

The BDT would like discussing with different companies the possibility of using Planning Tools for assisting the developing countries for the following purposes:

- Training and Trials
- Use of Tools from BDT for assisting the developing countries: e.g.: conditions for using the Tools for one month
- Delivering the Tools to the developing countries at privileged conditions
