Mrs Uryga is Deputy Director of Spectrum in Orange Group. She is responsible for frequency linked issues for UMTS/IMT-2000 and IMT-Advanced in relation to the forthcoming World Radiocommunication Conference (WRC-07). The scope of her work encompasses development of strategy for extension of UMTS coverage and policy related to estimation of market and related new spectrum needs for IMT-Advanced, in consultation with other operators and manufacturers. Mrs Uryga has been an active member of the French delegations to WRC-97, 2000 and 2003. She is actively involved in the work of a number of international fora developing UMTS/IMT-2000 and IMT-Advanced, such as ITU, CEPT, UMTS Forum, ETNO, ETSI. She participates also as associate member in the work of CITELE PCC II.

Mrs Uryga is the Chairperson of Operators Group in UMTS Forum from her election in 2002. She furthermore coordinated UMTS Forum activities linked with the World Radiocommunication Conferences (WRC-00 and WRC-03) and their preparations.

Mrs Uryga joined France Telecom in 1989. After several positions in commercial field, she has worked in the area of spectrum management since 1997. Halina Uryga is graduated from the Jaguellonian University (Cracovie, Poland) and the Paris II and Paris III Universities (France).
