

ITU seminar

“Transition from Analogue to Digital Broadcasting”

9 - 11 December 2008

Moscow, Russia

During the period from 9 to 11 December, 2008, the BDT ITU Seminar “Transition from Analogue to Digital Broadcasting” was held in Moscow, Russia. This event was organized at the kind invitation of the Ministry of Telecommunications and Mass Communications of the Russian Federation and hosted by the Advanced Telecommunications Training Institute (ATTI) of the Moscow Technical University of Communications and Informatics (MTUCI).

The Seminar was opened by Mr D.S. Severov, Deputy Minister of Telecommunications and Mass Communications of the Russian Federation, who delivered a keynote address on the subject of the seminar.

During the seminar 14 presentations on the international and country-specific technical and organizational problems of the transition from analogue to digital broadcasting including policy and regulatory, economic, technological aspects, were considered. The participants of the seminar visited the pilot digital TV- and radio- broadcasting area of the “Oktod” Company.

This seminar gathered together 64 participants from 14 CIS and CEE countries and RCC Executive Committee (Albania, Armenia, Azerbaijan, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Bulgaria, Kyrgyzstan, Latvia, Lithuania, Moldova, Slovenia, Russian Federation, Tajikistan, Ukraine, Uzbekistan).
