A. Relevant organizations (1)


- 3 key Ministries


- Leading organization in some areas

- First come first serve
 - Except domain names of government organizations
- Self-responsible
- English, Vietnamese
 - Vietnamnews.vn; thôngtấnxãviệtnam.vn

- "First come first sever", intellectual property right and speculation

C. Security (1)

- Issuing and harmonizing legislation framework on cyber-crime
 - IT Act, 6/2006: spam, virus, information security
 - Penal code, in process of revising
- Establishing high-tech crime unit
 - Vietnam High-Tech Crime Division, MPS, 2/2005



Security (2)

- Establising national CERT and international cooperation
 - VnCERT, 12/2005
 - In process of join APCERT (together with BKCERT)
 - Cooperation with ISPs, and relevant organizations
- Building trust by e-authentication
 - Electronic Transaction Act, 2005
 - Gov. Decree on Digital Signature, submitted to Government in Sep.06

Security (3)

- Other initiatives
 - Vietnam Information Security Union on process of establishment



Current issues

- Detail regulations on matters Spam, virus, phishing,...
- cyber-crime law
 - How to move ?

D. Openness

- IT Act, 2006 (Act. 8, 12)
 - Have rights to express, get/send information, ideas and knowledge except ones which are harmful to national security, peace and culture
- e-newspapers could be provided by private sectors
 - Newspapers are government owned



E. Diversity

- Vietnamese domain name
- websites in both Vietnamese and English (but not many)
- Draft of Digital Content Program 2006-2010 will be submitted to Gov in Dec.
 - E-Gov, e-commerce
 - E-health, e-education
 - **...**

F. Access

- ~ 20 ISPs/OSP licenses, ~half are operating
- Internet user penetration: 16%, increasing fast
- cheap price (30 cents/hour in Internet café)
- Internet for Community Project, 2004, VNPT
 - ~2000 villages (25%)
- Vietnam Telecom Fund (USF++), 11/2004
 - Access for rural, remote and low dentisity areas



G. Other matters

- Internet café
 - Inter-ministerial circular, 6/2005
 - Hard to control
- Online Games
 - Inter-ministerial circular, 4/2006

- Lot of efforts on Internet Governance
- Follows WSIS outcomes (Geneva Dec., Geneva & Tunis Plan of Action) and others (APEC Cybersecurity Strategy)
- Good progress in some matters (Internet access, domain name, security,...)
- Need more effort on
 - Internet content/application and
 - Cybersecurity (regulations)



Conclusion (2)

- Need envolvement of not only government but private sectors and Internet users
 - Create environtment for more envolvement
- Need cooperation with international organizations and other countries
 - ITU and Cambodia, Lao, Myanmar
