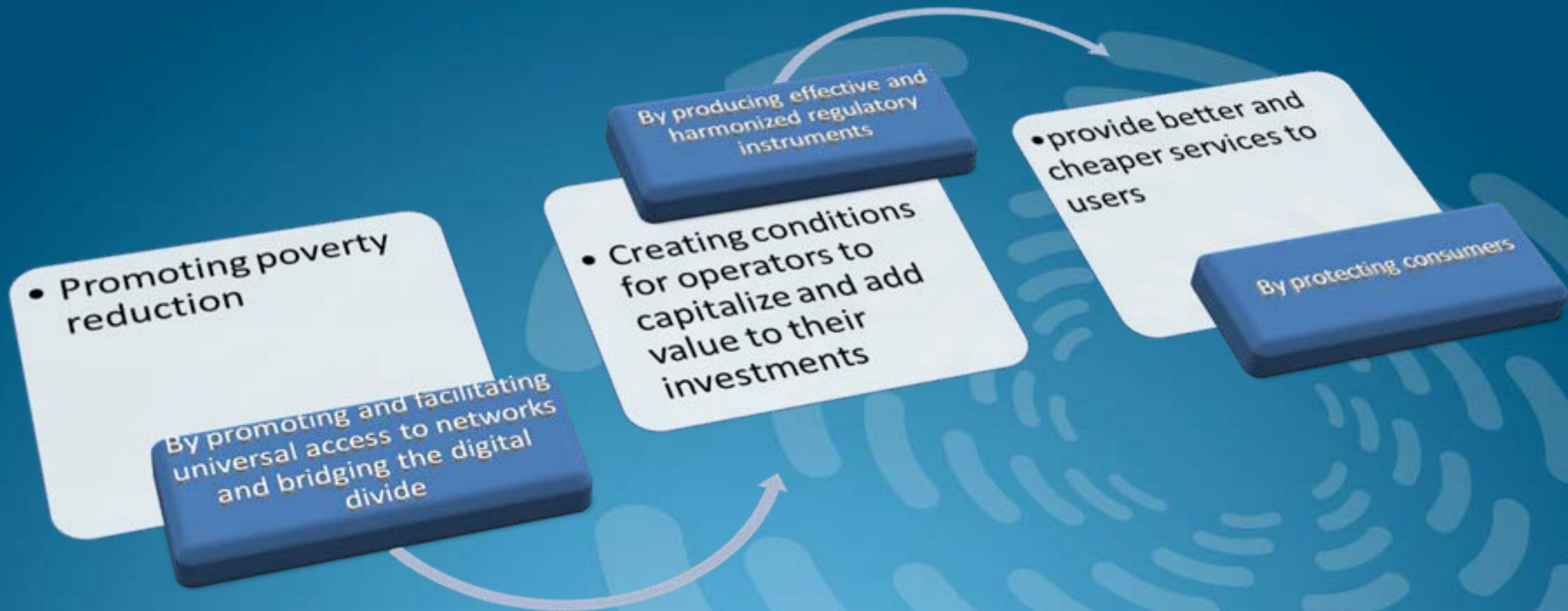

The challenge of Regulation at local level – looking for the right balance



It's consensual that ICT can contribute actively for the development of countries, however without an efficient and well-grounded regulatory process, efforts to use ICT for poverty reduction are less likely to be successful.

This is because the key to get right policies for poverty reduction using access to telecommunications networks involves achieving a stable and coherent regulatory framework that works within a developing economy where resources are particularly scarce.

 - contribute to the enhancement of the information society

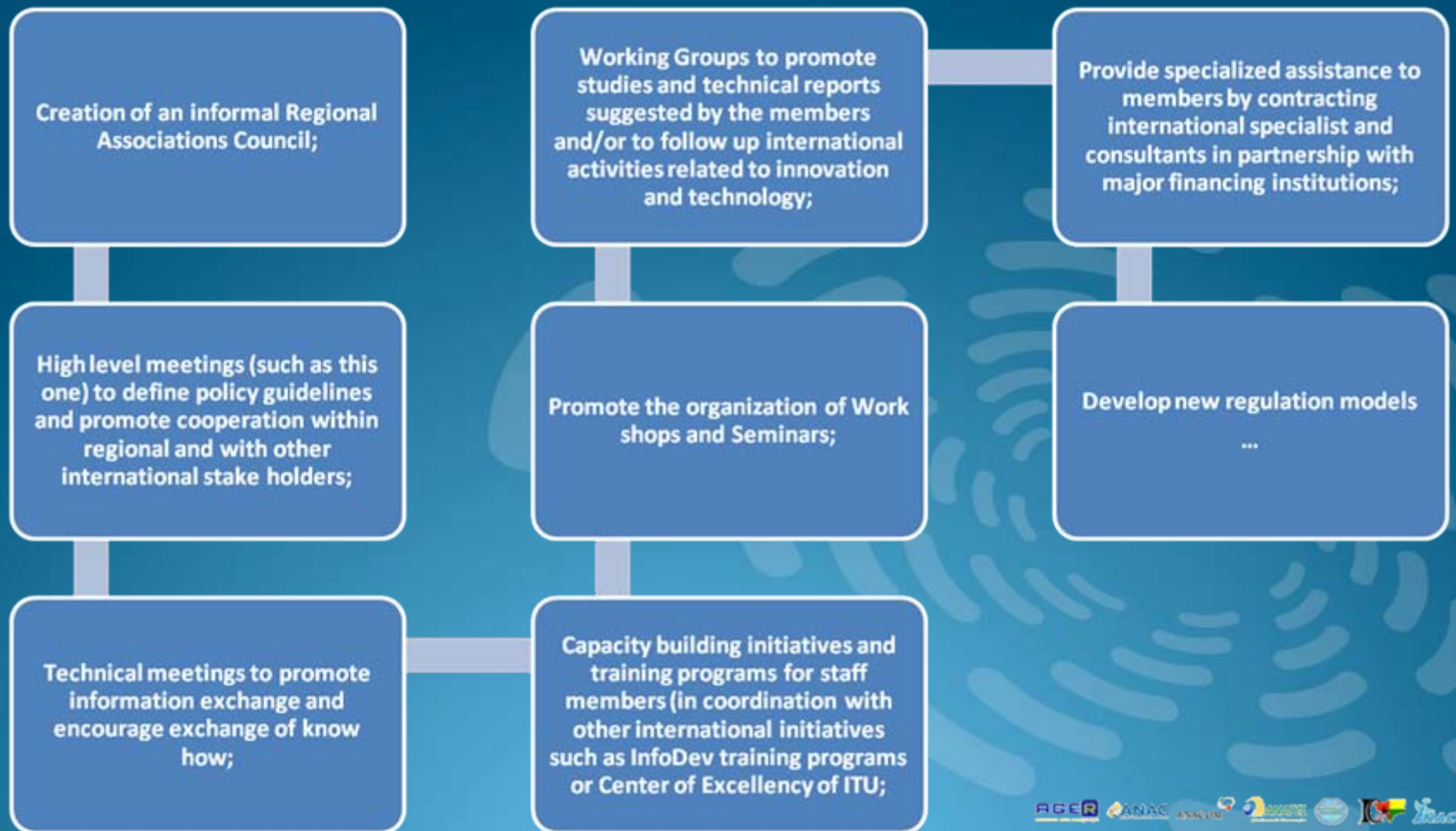
Inter Regional Regulators Association Drivers
