During this Forum we target to clarify:


1. What we, Young Leaders in ICTs Network, think about Internet Governance, Policy, Access, Security, and Diversity?





Practically, a perfect hexagonal pattern is not reached. Differences between the ideal shapes exist due to topographic limitations, local propagation conditions and site restrictions.




