Subject: Application of Nos. 5.136, 5.143, 5.146 and 5.151 of the Radio Regulations, and implementation of Resolution 21 (Rev.WRC-03) / Review of findings to frequency assignments to stations in the fixed or mobile services recorded in the MIFR after 1 April 2007

Part IIB of this BR IFIC contains 14 988 frequency assignments to stations in the fixed or mobile services still recorded in the MIFR after 1 April 2007, whose findings were reviewed in application of Nos. 5.136, 5.143, 5.146 and 5.151 of the Radio Regulations, and in accordance with Resolution 21 (Rev.WRC-03). The review resulted in favourable findings for 10 552 assignments and in unfavourable findings for 4 436 assignments. It is recalled that pursuant to provisions Nos. 5.136, 5.143, 5.146 and 5.151, as from 1 April 2007, the use of the bands 5 900- 5 950 kHz, 7 300-7 350 kHz, 9 400-9 500 kHz, 11 600-11 650 kHz, 12 050-12 100 kHz, 13 570-13 600 kHz, 13 800-13 870 kHz, 15 600-15 800 kHz, 17 480-17 550 kHz and 18 900-19 020 kHz by the fixed service and in some cases also by the land mobile service or the mobile except aeronautical mobile (R) service is limited to communications within the boundaries of the countries in which they are located, and on condition that harmful interference is not caused to the broadcasting service.

In accordance with Resolution 21 (Rev.WRC-03), the Bureau invited the administrations, through Circular Letter CR/218 (dated 8 September 2004) and several multi-address letters, to re-accomodate their frequency assignments in other appropriate frequency bands, or to take any other appropriate corrective action.
