Subject: Replacement of the three-letter code for Timor-Leste

As from issue 2618 of 29 April 2008, the BR IFIC (terrestrial services) reflects the changes related to the replacement of the former three-letter code "TMP", associated with the former nomination Portuguese Timor, by the new code "TLS", established by ISO (International Standardization Organization) to comply with new nomination Timor-Leste.

The following modifications have been made by the BR in its databases and documents:

- 1) The former code "TMP" has been replaced by the new code "TLS" in the field "geographical area" of the entries in the Master Register, the regional plan associated with the Regional Agreements GE75 and the relevant records related to frequency allotments of AP25 and AP26 Plans.
- 2) The former code "TMP" has been also replaced by the new code "TLS" in the tables "Administrations" and "Geographical areas" of the Preface to the BR IFIC (see Chapter IV, sections 1 and 2).
- 3) The ITU Digital World Map (IDWM) has been updated accordingly to reflect the change in codes described above.
