System description and specifications

1- General description

The Radiocommunication Bureau announced the implementation of WISFAT through <u>Circular Letter</u> <u>CR/297 dated 20 January 2009</u>.

Since the above date, submissions of frequency assignment/allotment notices to the BR (Terrestrial Services only) shall be made via the *WISFAT* interface.

Considering that the transition period during which submissions received via brmail@itu.int were also accepted has expired, administrations are informed that the BR can no longer process notices concerning Terrestrial Services submitted via email.


Access to the WISFAT interface is restricted to registered *notifiers* only, and administrations can nominate several *notifiers* as required.


For registering in the BR as a *notifier*, an official request should be sent by the administration to brmail@itu.int indicating, inter-alia, the notifiers' TIES user name(s).


In addition, each administration shall indicate their email address to be used by WISFAT for official communication of automatic acknowledgment of receipts.





3- Actions performed after confirmation of submission

Automatic acknowledgement of receipt to the *notifier* and to the email address entered under the label "email_for_acknowledgement" shall be sent after submission has been correctly received and stored by the system.
