² **Definitions**

– *Accounting authority:*

The administration of the country that has issued the licence for a ship station (or the recognized private operating agency or other entity/entities designated by the administration in accordance with the provisions L1 to L6 of ITU-T Recommendation D.90) to whom maritime accounts in respect of ship stations licensed by that country may be sent.

– *Accounting authority identification code (AAIC):*

The discrete identification code of the accounting authority responsible for the settlement of maritime accounts (see Annex A to ITU-T Recommendation D.90).
