Reference: Article 16 and No. 20.12 of the Radio Regulations

To the Director General

Dear Sir / Madam,

The Radiocommunication Bureau is now preparing the 11th Edition of the List of International Monitoring Stations (List VIII). This List contains the following:

- Part I: Part IA. Centralizing offices* and their addresses
Part IB. Alphabetical index of stations.
- Part II: Particulars of monitoring stations carrying out measurements related to stations of terrestrial radiocommunication services.

The stations are grouped under their Administration/Geographical area names and are arranged in the alphabetical order of their symbols. The particulars of stations for each grouping are indicated in five sections as follows:

Section A - Stations carrying out frequency measurements,

Section B - Stations carrying out field strength or power flux-density measurements,

Section C - Stations carrying out direction-finding measurements,

Section D - Stations carrying out bandwidth measurements,

Section E - Stations carrying out automatic spectrum occupancy surveys.

- Part III: Particulars of monitoring stations carrying out measurements related to stations in the space radiocommunication services.

The stations are grouped alphabetically under the symbol of the names of their respective Administration/Geographical area.

- Map of monitoring stations.

The attention of administrations is invited to ITU-R Recommendation SM.1139, referred to in Article 16 of the Radio Regulations, which *recommends* "that administrations having determined whether the monitoring stations meet adequate technical standards, shall notify to the Radiocommunication Bureau pertinent information on the centralizing office and on the stations they wish to have included in List VIII, clearly identifying those stations which may participate in the international monitoring system".
