Super distribution was proposed early 80's to provide the win-win relationship between hardware vendors and holders for digital contents delivery and consumption. The idea encourages hardware vendors to implement the secure system in spite of cost up by providing the revenue share to them. To reach this goal, PT62224(Conceptual Model for Digital Rights Management) and surveying the holders' concerns, PT62227(Digital Rights Permission Code) are being developed.
