

## VIP PROGRAMME POLICY ADMISSION FOR ITU TELECOM WORLD 2009

The VIP programme is a peer network of ICT government, industry leaders and decision-makers from all stakeholders groups and regions. This community will engage in new dialogues and social networking, foster new partnerships and seek practical solutions and responses to today's pressing issues in the telecom and ICT sector.

These leaders come from the worlds of politics, business, civil society, and academia, including Ministers, Senior Officials, Director Generals of the Administration, Head of Regulatory Agencies, Heads of UN Agencies and International Organizations, and CEOs, as well as other top managers from other sectors.

Access to the VIP Programme is by invitation only from ITU TELECOM and is conditional on having a VIP Global Pass. This pass gives access to the VIP Programme, all Forum sessions and the Exhibition. This pass will be granted by the ITU according to the following rules.

### Admission Policy

- 1) **National Delegation VIPs:** For these delegations, 5 VIP Global passes are granted to the following delegates. These invitations can be transferable to other senior officials.
  - Ministers
  - Head of Administration
  - Head of Regulatory Agency
  - Advisor to the Minister
  - Ambassadors
  
- 2) **Industry VIPs:** The CEOs of those actively participating companies, i.e., as individual exhibitors, sponsors or as a Forum Speaker, are given a VIP Global Pass by right. These invitations to the VIP programme are not transferable. Other CEOs and other C-level executives are required to purchase a VIP Global Pass.
