

PARTICIPATION GUIDELINES FOR ITU-D SGs (Plenaries)

- Please check that your microphone and camera are muted once the meeting starts.
- If you would like to intervene, please raise your hand with the “raise hand” button located at the bottom of the participants window. To access the participants window, click the “Participants” button in the bottom bar of the Zoom interface.
- The Chairman (or Moderator) of the session will address you by name once you are invited to take the floor (make sure you go to the interpretation channel of the language you are speaking). You will be able to unmute yourselves to speak. After your intervention, kindly make sure your microphone is muted again.

- You may use the chat for any questions or comments. Moderators will be monitoring, and any comment may be read out, if needed.
- Interpretation in the 6 languages of the Union and captioning services are provided. You can enable interpretation through the “Interpretation” button in the bottom bar of the Zoom interface and selecting your preferred language, and captioning by clicking on the “Closed Caption” button and selecting “Show Subtitle”.
- We kindly invite you to use the latest version of Zoom (version 5.2.1 or above) release to ensure that interpretation works properly. The link to download is given in the chat.

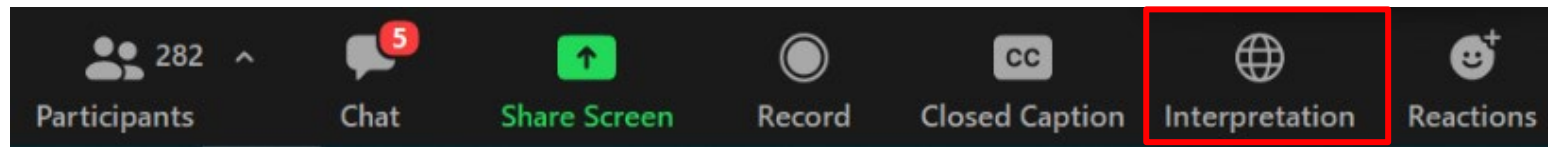

How to enable interpretation and captioning with Zoom

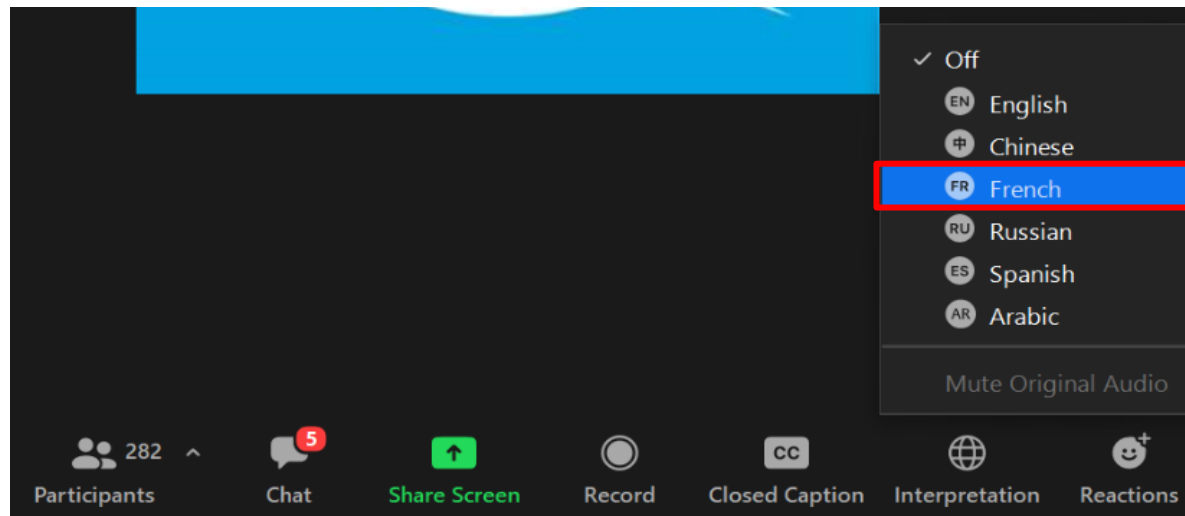
To enable interpretation:

Important: To enable interpretation, you must **download and install the latest version of Zoom**. The latest version is available here: <https://itu.zoom.us/download>

1. Click on the “Interpretation” button

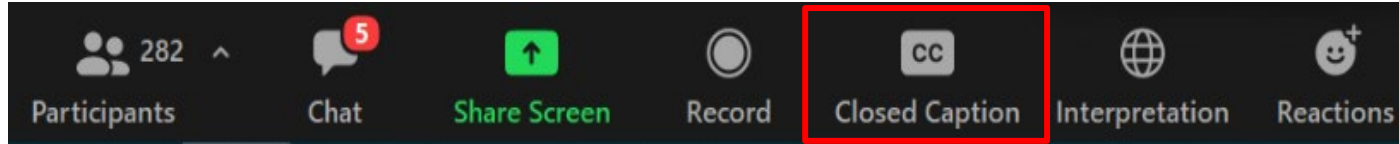


2. In the menu that appears, select the preferred language (e.g. French in this example)

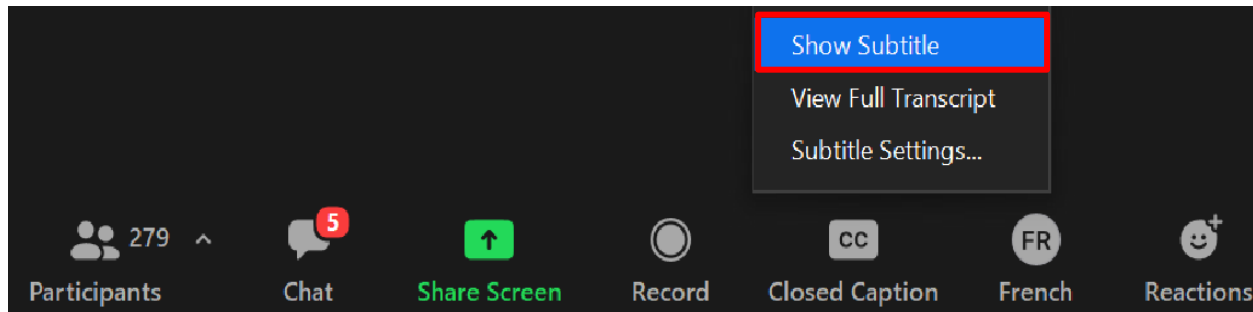


How to enable captioning

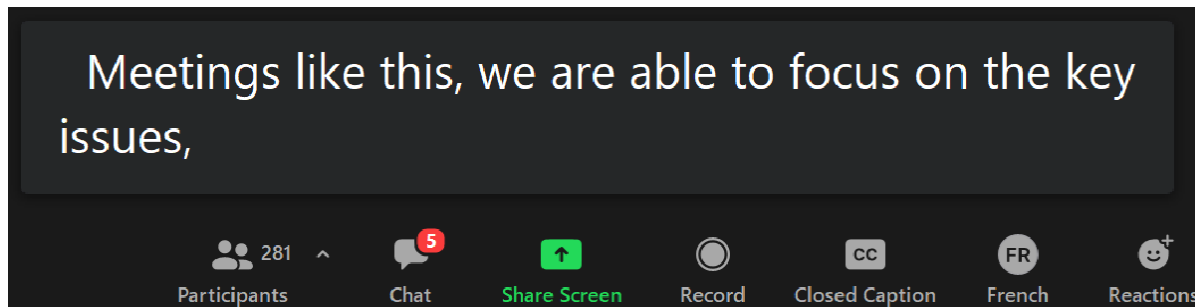
1. Click on the “Closed Caption” button



2. In the menu that appears, click on “Show Subtitle”

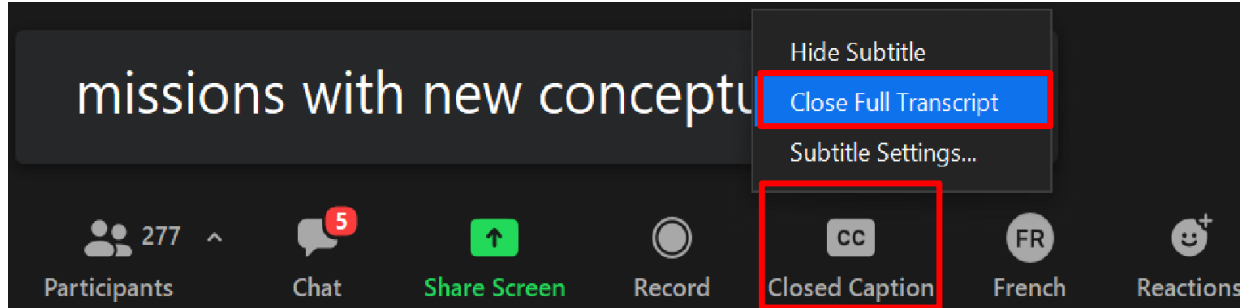


3. You will see captioning on the screen

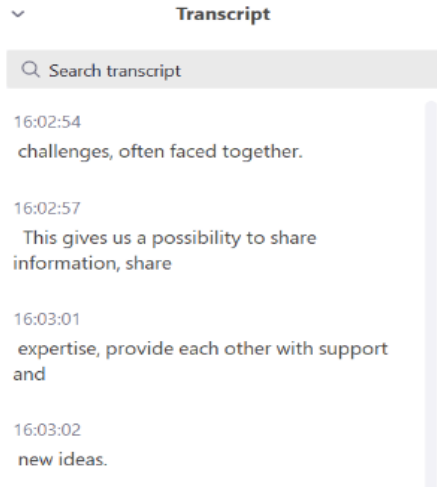


To see the full transcript in Zoom

- Push the “Closed Caption” button and select “View Full Transcript” item



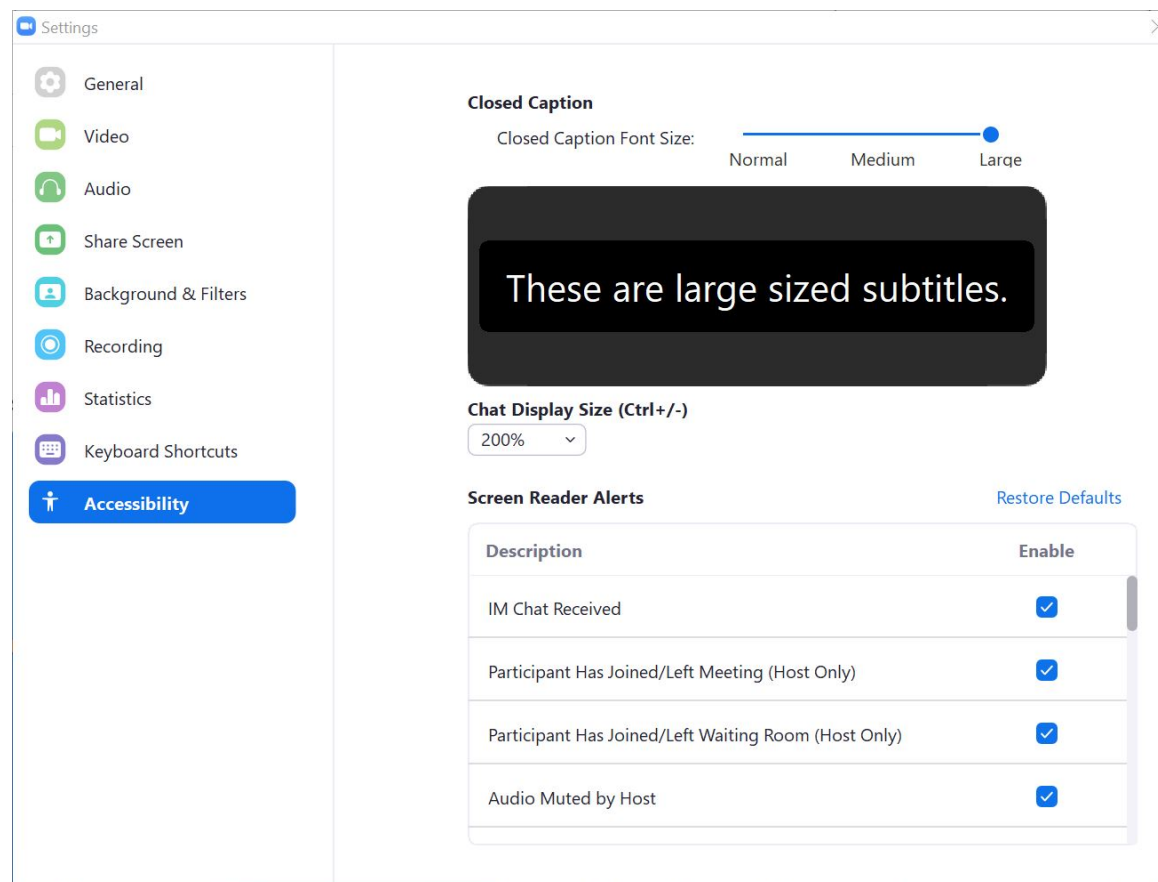
- A full captioning transcript window will appear on the right



How to see the full transcript and adjust text size

To change options (e.g. font size) for captioning:

Push the “Closed Caption” button and select “Subtitle Settings” from the menu that appears. The following window will then appear to change settings to match your preferences:
