Satellite services

By Administrative Circular CAR/266 dated 18 November 2008, 1 draft new Recommendation and 1 draft revised Recommendation were submitted for simultaneous adoption and approval by correspondence (PSAA), following the procedure of Resolution ITU-R 1-5 (§ 10.3). In addition, the Study Group proposed the suppression of 8 Recommendations.

The conditions governing this procedure were met for Recommendation ITU-R S.1844 on 18 February 2009, but the draft revision of Recommendation ITU-R S.465-5 was not adopted and will be returned to Working Party 4A for further discussion.

The approved Recommendation will be published by the ITU and Annex 1 to this Circular provides its title, with the assigned number. Annex 2 provides the list of suppressed Recommendations.
