Subject: INTERSPUTNIK-98.5ECK

Dear Sir,

1. After the dispatch of the Circular Telegram referred to above, the Radiocommunication Bureau has subsequently received a communication from the Administration of Belarus, dated 8 August 2008, concerning the INTERSPUTNIK-98.5ECK satellite network filing.
2. The Bureau noted the confirmation by this Administration of the bringing into use of some frequency assignments of the INTERSPUTNIK-98.5ECK satellite network with a satellite named "Protostar-1". Resolution 49 information was also provided at the same time and has been published in the BR IFIC 2627 of 2 September 2008. The Bureau understands that the "Protostar-1" satellite is operating such frequency assignments within the envelope characteristics published in the INTERSPUTNIK-98.5ECK coordination request Special Section CR/C1764, BR IFIC 2574/25.07.2006.
3. In view of the above, the Bureau concluded that all frequency assignments of the "Protostar-1" satellite are currently operated under the responsibility of the Republic of Belarus, acting as notifying Administration of the Intersputnik Intergovernmental Satellite Organization.
4. The Bureau trusts that the above information will prove useful to your Administration and remains at your disposal for any inquiry you may have in this respect.
