Communication of 23.II.1999*:

The *Entidad Pública Empresarial Correos y Telégrafos de España*, Madrid, which currently has over 1 400 Bureaufax offices, announces that it intends to open the international facsimile service between public offices (Bureaufax) with any administrations/ROAs that so wish.

It has concluded agreements with 90 countries for the exchange of this class of traffic in conformity with the following basic rules:

1. In principle, accounts pertaining to this service will not be settled until such time as the volume of traffic exchanged makes this necessary. Each administration/ROA will retain the amounts charged to their customers ("SKA" (sender keeps all) method).
2. Traffic is transmitted fully automatically via the public switched telephone network (PSTN).
3. This service will be operated in accordance with ITU-T Recommendation F.170.

Communication of 19.II.1999

Closure of the Barbados telex switching centre

Cable and Wireless BET Ltd., (C&WBET), Bridgetown, announces the planned closure of the Barbados Telex Switching Centre. All traffic destined for this facility will have to be routed via the Cable and Wireless Communications (CWC) telex switch at Bracknell, United Kingdom.

The CWC switch will commence accepting the above-mentioned traffic on 3 April 1999 at 1700 hours UTC (1700 hours GMT). After this date, CWC will be the sole switching facility for the aforementioned traffic.

All outward traffic which is currently sent from the C&WBET telex switch will be routed via the CWC telex switch as of 3 April 1999. The C&WBET telex switch of Barbados (telex destination code 392) currently also provides longlined terminal switching for the following telex destination codes (TDC) (ITU-T Recommendation F.69) 394, 395, 398, 399, which identify traffic for the following countries: Dominica, Grenada, Saint Lucia and Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, respectively. Consequently, telex traffic to and from Barbados telex subscribers or subscribers longlined to the C&WBET Telex Switching Centre will have to be routed via CWC at Bracknell, United Kingdom.

The CWC telex exchange will replace the C&WBET telex exchange in all respects, so that the C&WBET telex customers will perceive no change in service. The responsibility for international rates and settlement will reside with CWC as from 3 April 1999.

Virtual Public Telex Network Facility

Cable and Wireless Communications Ltd, Bracknell, announces that it will soon provide a virtual public telex network (VPTN) facility enabling the provision of a local (in country) real time telex service without the need for operating a full telex exchange. The VPTN subscribers will be long-lined to the Cable and Wireless Communications (CWC) telex exchange at Bracknell, United Kingdom.

The CWC telex exchange at Bracknell has the capacity and capability to be logically partitioned to mimic the replaced telex exchange in all aspects, such as telex answer-back code of the originating country, local date and time stamp. Therefore the target country's telex customers see no outward change to the service that is being offered. They have no identity change issue to consider and no need to alter any of their current operating procedures and practices. In place of their existing telex exchange, the VPTN customers will require multiplexing and / or concentration equipment to which their present national telex lines will be reterminated via the existing line or multiplexer interfaces.

The first VPTN customer will be Cable and Wireless BET Ltd, Barbados. Consequently, the telex subscribers of Barbados and those of other administrations/ROAs which are longlined on to the C&WBET Barbados telex exchange will be switched from the Cable and Wireless Communications (CWC) telex exchange at Bracknell, United Kingdom.

The foreseen date for the cut-over wherein all telex traffic will be switched from the CWC telex exchange at Bracknell, United Kingdom, instead of the C&WBET Barbados telex exchange, is 3 April 1999 at 1700 hours GMT (1700 hours UTC). It is expected that the C&WBET Barbados telex exchange be powered down and decommissioned as from 30 June 1999. The administrations/ROAs will be informed in due course by ITU circular telegram.
