The conditions governing the approval of ITU-T Recommendations were met and 16 Member States participating in the last meeting of Study Group 5 approved the text of these Recommendations during the Plenary session held on 25 February 2000.

The conditions governing the deletion of ITU-T Recommendations were met and 11 Member States participating in the last meeting of Study Group 12 proposed to delete the text of these Recommendations. Ten Administrations of Member States responded to the consultation on 21 January 2000, and no objection to the deletion was received.
