Telephone Service

France

Communication of 7.XII.2000:

The *Autorité de Régulation des Télécommunications*, Paris, announces that, as certain telephone service providers and operators in France have complained that network operators of other countries have not been routing traffic to them, it would regard it as helpful to publish the following communication, simply to inform all interested parties of the E.164 destination codes currently in service after the country code +33 for accessing geographic fixed or mobile service subscribers with a number in metropolitan France.

Reminders

The numbering plan in metropolitan France is a closed plan with the following format:

CC (+33) + N(S)N (nine digits) where: CC = country code N(S)N = national (significant) number, more specifically: +33 ZABPQMCDU.

(It is customary practice in France for the sequence of digits of a national significant number to be designated by the following letters: 1st digit: Z, 2nd digit: A, 3rd digit: B, 4th digit: P, 5th digit: Q, 6th digit: M, 7th digit: C, 8th digit: D, 9th digit: U.)

The ZAB for which "various operators" is indicated are shared by several operators; specific details may be found on the website of the Autorité de Régulation des Télécommunications at <http://www.art-telecom.fr>.

The relevant information may be obtained as follows:

- 1) On the home page "*sommaire*" (summary), select the scroll-down window "*accès rapide*" (fast access).
- 2) In the "*accès rapide*", select "*numérotation*" (numbering).
- 3) On the page which then appears with the heading: "*Cet outil de recherche a pour but de fournir des informations sur l'utilisation des ressources du plan de numérotation français*" (this search engine is designed to provide information on use of the French numbering plan resources), click on the link "*cliquez ici*" (click here) in the paragraph entitled "*Recherche*" (search).
- 4) The page containing the search engine for French numbers then appears. The code [0ZAB] (in digits) should be entered (not forgetting the zero!) in the window featuring the "*Recherche*" button.
- 5) A page then appears displaying either:
 - an actual list of operators with the PQ digits assigned to them; their addresses may then be obtained by clicking on the "*adresse*" (address) link; or
 - "*il y a plus de 50 réponses veuillez préciser par un chiffre supplémentaire*" (there are over 50 replies, please specify further by indicating an additional digit). The sequences of values 0ZAB1, 0ZAB2, 0ZAB3, etc. should then be entered into the search engine in order to obtain the operators' names, and subsequently their addresses by clicking on the "*adresse*" links.

The numbering information is updated each week by the *Autorité de Régulation des Télécommunications*. Numbers recently assigned to operators are therefore readily obtainable and can be taken into account by operators from other countries.

Remarks

Geographic numbers and mobile numbers are not the only types of number in the French numbering plan. The following categories also exist:

- 1) Short numbers (four digits beginning with the digit 1 or the digit 3); these are not accessible from other countries.
- 2) Non-geographic fixed service numbers (freephone numbers, shared-cost numbers and shared-revenue numbers); for these numbers $Z = 8$ with an $A \neq 5$. Whether or not they can be accessed from abroad is determined on a case-by-case basis through bilateral agreements between the incumbent operator and certain operators of other countries.
- 3) Special numbers comprising two or three digits that are not accessible from other countries.

In future, when changes are made to the list of ZAB indicated in this communication (by the addition of new ZAB or the suppression of certain existing ZAB), the *Autorité de Régulation des Télécommunications* will publish a communication listing the changes.
