Hungary

Communication of 27.X.2001:

Bolivia (country code +591)

Communication of 26.IX.2001*:

The *Superintendencia de Telecomunicaciones (SITTEL)*, La Paz, announces that a new telephone numbering plan will be introduced on 20 October 2001 at 0500 hours UTC. The change will affect all fixed and mobile telephone numbers in Bolivia.

- *Fixed telephony*

What changes will be made in fixed telephony?

The National (Significant) Number (N(S)N) will be increased from seven to eight digits. At the present time, the N(S)N is seven digits long and is formed by a subscriber's telephone number ranging from four to six digits, and an area code ranging from one to three digits.

As from 20 October 2001, the subscriber's number throughout the country will have a uniform length of seven digits as a result of fusing the present area codes and the subscriber's telephone number. Hence, a new area code identifier, named Numbering Zone and formed by one digit, will be added.

The numbering zones are:

- *Mobile telephony*

What changes will be made in mobile telephony?

At present, the N(S)N of a mobile telephone is seven digits long and begins with "1" or "7".

As from 20 October 2001, all mobile telephones in Bolivia will have an eight-digit N(S)N. With this change, all mobile telephone numbers will start with the digit "7". The second number of the new N(S)N will identify the mobile service operator.

How should a call to a mobile telephone in Bolivia be placed as from 20 October 2001?

To call a mobile telephone in Bolivia as from 20 October 2001, one should dial +591 7 PXXXXXX
