All telegrams for delivery in the United Kingdom should use the Telegram Destination Indicator "GBXX". Only ordinary rate telegrams are accepted. Addresses may be TFX (telephonic address), FAXx (facsimile address), TLXx (telex address) or full postal addresses. Valid Registered Telegraphic Addresses are also acceptable. Unitel's terminal accounting rate requirement for telegrams to the United Kingdom is 0.229 SDR per ordinary word.
