Mongolia

– Communication of 7.XII.2004:

The *Government of Mongolia*, Ulaanbaatar, announces that, in accordance with Resolution 207 by the Government of Mongolia, the former Policy and Coordination Department for Information and Communication Technology (ICT) of the Ministry of Infrastructure (MOI) and the Post and Telecommunications Authority (PTA) – the implementary agency of the Government of Mongolia, were restructured into new Government Agency “Information and Communications Technology Authority (ICTA)” as from 20 October 2004.

Mr Ch. Saikhanbileg has been newly appointed as the Chairman of ICTA of Mongolia.
