

WASHINGTON - The Bush administration is proposing a sweeping overhaul of the way the government regulates the nation's financial services industry from banks and securities firms to mortgage brokers and insurance companies.

The proposal would allow the Fed, in its new role as "market stability regulator," to dispatch examiners to check the books not just of commercial banks but of all segments of the financial services industry.

The plan would create a national regulator for the insurance industry, which is now largely governed by the states, and would create a Mortgage Origination Commission to try to address the abuses exposed in the current tidal wave of mortgage defaults. If there is a disagreement over the name of the used economic model, let us borrow the newest financial approach of the US administration and apply it to the activities of ICT all over the world.

Engine Control Unit (ECU)

ECU is a piece of ICT equipment


ECU cuts off the fuel supply if RPM are maximum, but it should depend on the atmospheric pressure as well.

The engine output is proportional to RPM, but if the increment of RPM is less than a pre-set value, then fuel increment should be reduced to Zero.


Driving in towns should be fully controlled by ICT monitoring equipment – Intelligent Transport Systems
