- **Persons with disabilities feel that the Focus Group has made a difference** to AV media.

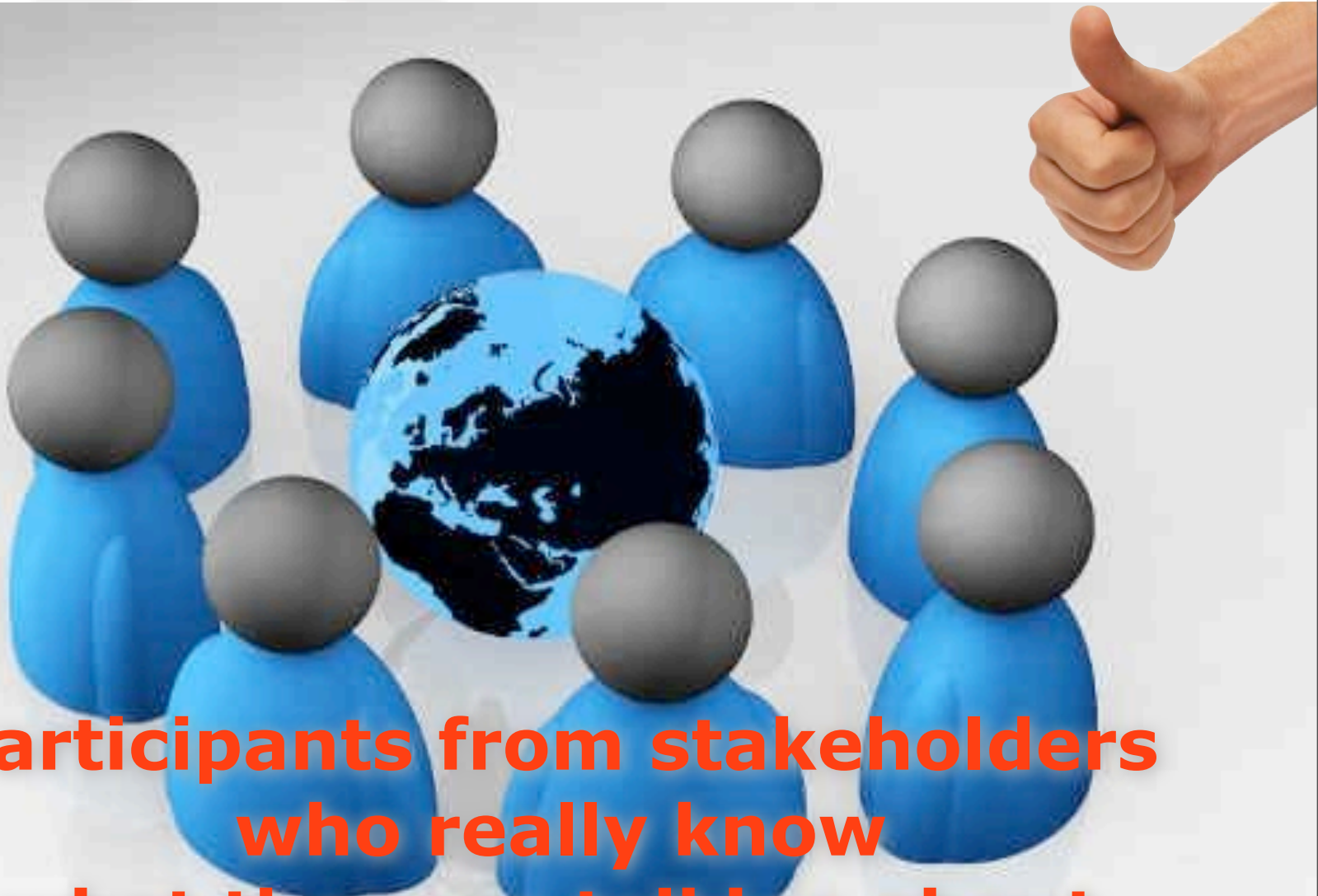
