2 Getting to Scientific Atlanta

From the Atlanta Hartsfield Jackson International Airport (ATL)

The best way to get to Scientific Atlanta is to rent a car at the airport. Directions from the airport are detailed here. This trip takes approximately 45 minutes.

- 1. Leaving the airport, follow signs for route 85 North towards Atlanta.
- 2. After about 35 miles, take GA-316 East towards Lawrenceville/Athens
- 3. Take the Sugarloaf Parkway Exit off of GA-316 East
- 4. Turn Right onto Sugarloaf Parkway
- 5. The entrance to Scientific Atlanta is on your right at the first traffic light you come to.
- 6. Follow signs for visitor parking and let the receptionist know that Michael Shannon is expecting you.




Figure 1: Map from ATL to Scientific Atlanta, Sugarloaf campus

4.1 Passports and Visas

All foreign visitors entering the United States (US) must have a valid passport. Visitors from countries whose citizens require a visa should at the earliest time and well in advance of travel apply for a visa at a US Embassy or consulate. 



4.2 Electrical Appliances

Throughout the U.S. electrical appliances operate from 120V, 60Hz. power supplies with plugs as shown below. It is suggested guests bring their own power converters and wall plug adapters to allow use of international appliances. Hotels typically provide irons, ironing boards and hair dryers in the hotel rooms, so there is no need to bring these items with you.
