RECOMMENDATION ITU-R M.1042

DISASTER COMMUNICATIONS IN THE AMATEUR AND AMATEUR-SATELLITE SERVICES

(Question ITU-R 48/8)

(1994)

The ITU Radiocommunication Assembly,

considering

a) Resolution No. 640 of the Radio Regulations (RR), relating to the international use of radiocommunications, in the event of natural disasters, in frequency bands allocated to the amateur service;

b) RR No. 510, which refers to the use of the bands allocated to the amateur service in the event of natural disasters,

recommends

1. that administrations encourage the development of amateur and amateur-satellite service networks capable of providing communications in the event of natural disasters;

2. that such networks be robust, flexible and independent of other telecommunications services and capable of operating from emergency power;

3. that amateur organizations be allowed to exercise their networks periodically during normal non-disaster periods.
