INTRODUCTION

- Established on July 1, 2008 in Malta
- Independent platform of Regulatory Authorities for Electronic Communications Networks and Services
- Membership **regulatory authorities** that are parties:
 - to the Body of European Regulators for Electronic Communications (BEREC)
 - to the Euro-Mediterranean Partnership (launched within the framework of the Barcelona Declaration of 28th November 1995 and confirmed by the European Neighborhood Policy)
- Currently **22 Members**: Algeria, Austria, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Croatia, Cyprus, Egypt, France, Germany, Greece, Israel, Italy, Jordan, Lebanon, Malta, Morocco, State of Palestine, Portugal, Spain, Switzerland, Syria, Tunisia and Turkey

STRUCTURE

№ Plenary Assembly

- representatives of the Member (*President, CEO, designated Board Member*)
- once a year

Contact Network

- representatives of the Member/Observer
- once a year, before the Plenary Assembly

Permanent Secretariat

- representatives of 5 different Members on voluntary basis
- appointed every year by the Plenary Assembly

Chair and Vice-Chair

- appointed by the Plenary Assembly for a one-year term
- current Chair Italy, for 2018 Egypt
- European Commission has the right to send observers of an appropriate level to any EMERG meeting/activity



OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

- Improvement of the **relations** and fostering **cooperation** amongst Members by:
 - acting as a forum for regular discussions and exchanges of information on issues relating to electronic communications;
 - promoting the approximation to the European regulatory framework and best practices among its Members;
 - monitoring the development of the electronic communications in the Mediterranean area;
 - facilitating the cooperation and exchange of ideas and expertise with international organizations, other regulatory networks and sector experts;
 - preparing and contributing to the preparation of a region's reservoir of documents, reports, benchmarks, presentations, analyses and common positions
