CURRENCY and BANKING INFORMATION

The local currency in Cambodia is the Cambodian Riel (Riel). Riel is available in Riel 100, Riel 500, Riel 1,000, Riel 5,000, Riel 10,000, Riel 50,000, Riel 100,000 bank notes.

The Cambodian Riel is pegged to the value of the U.S. Dollar and both currencies can be used in Cambodia.

USD1.00 = Riel 3,900 approx.

EUR1.00 = Riel 5,170 approx.

Banking Hours

Banks are generally open from 9am to 4pm on weekdays and 9am to 11am on Saturday. Most banks are government-approved to handle traveler's cheques and currency exchange, and most offer ATMs on international networks.
