Dear Sir/Madam,

I have the honour to inform you that, following the kind invitation of the Government of Argentina and the approval by the Council with the concurrence of a majority of the Member States of ITU, the forthcoming World Telecommunication Development Conference (WTDC-17) of the ITU will be convened in **Buenos Aires, Argentina, from 9 to 20 October 2017**.

In accordance with Article 25 of the ITU Convention and Section 3 of the General Rules of conferences, assemblies and meetings of the Union, I therefore have great pleasure in hereby inviting your entity to send representatives to WTDC-17.

World telecommunication development conferences (WTDCs) are convened in the period between two Plenipotentiary Conferences to consider topics, projects and programmes relevant to telecommunication development. WTDCs set the strategies and objectives for the development of telecommunication/ICT, providing direction and guidance to the ITU Telecommunication Development Sector (ITU-D).

The theme of WTDC-17 is "ICT for Sustainable Development Goals" (ICT SDGs). The draft agenda of WTDC-17, as approved by the Council with the concurrence of a majority of the Member States, is contained in Annex 1. In line with WTDC Resolution 31 (Rev. Hyderabad, 2010), the ITU Telecommunication Development Bureau (BDT) is organizing one Regional Preparatory Meeting (RPM) per region, two in the last quarter of 2016 and four in the first quarter of 2017. A schedule of these meetings is attached as Annex 2.

The draft structure of WTDC-17, along with the practical details concerning registration and the procedure and deadline for the submission of contributions will be sent to you in due course.

I very much look forward to your participation and contributions to ensure that the WTDC-17 Declaration, ITU-D contribution to the ITU Strategic Plan and ITU-D Action Plan, to be adopted by WTDC-17, will be effective tools for guiding the work of ITU-D in the coming years to meet the needs of all countries.

In line with ITU gender equality and mainstreaming policy and Resolution 198 (Busan, 2014) on empowerment of youth through telecommunication/ICT, I would also like to take the opportunity to encourage you to include women and young people in your delegation.
