- To develop proposals from APT Members that considers the interest of the Asia-Pacific region as inputs for WTDCs;
- To develop inputs from APT Members for ITU RPM for Asia and the Pacific;
- To assist APT Members during the WTDC.

So far, the APT Preparatory Group for WTDC-17 has already met two times. The first meeting was held in Singapore in August last year and the second meeting was recently hosted in Papua New Guinea in February this year. I would like to bring to your attention that the Group approved the document "APT view on draft regional initiatives for the Asia and the Pacific region" which will be discussed here during these three days.

I have also noticed that a number of the outcomes of discussion at the APT Preparatory meeting have been submitted to this RPM in order to have another consultation with the ITU membership. This will subsequently facilitate the process of setting up APT common proposals to WTDC-17 in the future. During the course of the deliberation, APT will be at the disposal of the Memberships of both APT and ITU thereby making the RPM and the WTDC achieve their objectives and fully meet our expectations.
