Visa requirements

Kindly check current visa requirements with your respective embassies, consulates, Ministry of Foreign Affairs or travel agent before travelling. The procedure to obtain a visa can be accessed through the following website:

While holders of Diplomatic Passports or Ordinary Passports from ASEAN Member States do not require a visa to enter Indonesia, other Asia Pacific countries may need a visa to enter Indonesia. No matter what type of visa you are going to use, your passport must be valid for at least six months from the date of your arrival.

2. Countries whose nationals require a visa

Countries which are not included in table above should submit their visa request to the nearest Indonesian consular representation at least two weeks prior to the event.

If an Indonesian consulate/embassy is not available in the participants' country or nearby country, participants may obtain a visa on arrival at Soekarno-Hatta International Airport, Jakarta or Ngurah Rai International Airport, Bali, by submitting the following documents:

- official confirmation of registration from ITU bearing a unique ID number,
- photocopy of passport,
- photocopy of return ticket,
- a fee of USD 35.

Participants falling under Indonesian calling visa countries category shall apply for such visa by submitting the following documents to the nearest Indonesian consular representation, with a copy to the Ministry of Communications and Information Technologies (MCIT) at least two weeks prior to the meeting:

- official confirmation of registration from ITU bearing a unique ID number,
- photocopy of passport passport should be valid for at least six months after the end of the stay in Indonesia,
- nomination letter from administration (in the case of ITU Member States)/organization (in the case of ITU-D Sector Members, Associates or ITU Academia,
- hotel reservation, and
- photocopy of return ticket.
