Immigration Requirements

Rwanda issues visas to all African Nationals upon arrival at Kigali International Airport. Entry visa are applied for online:

Currency and Banks

There is no limit to how much you can bring into country. Rwandan currency is denominated in Rwandan Francs (FRW). There are authorized currency exchange centers at Kigali International Airport and throughout the city center; currency exchange is also available at Kigali Serena Hotel. ATM machines around the city also accept Visa cards; for Master Card and American Express, make sure to visit the Bank of Kigali Main Branch in the city center and three-minute drive from Kigali Serena hotel. Please note that it is highly advisable to carry adequate cash in local currency as acceptance of credit cards is limited to a few hotels and restaurants.

It will be responsibility of the participant to ensure that his/her flight information are communicated to the host on time to facilitate this activity. The organizer (ITU) shall coordinate the sharing of this information as participants register with ITU. Similarly, transportation to and from the venue, in the morning and evening respectively, will be provided by the host to all participants who will be staying in the Hotels proposed by the host or any other hotel not far from the venue. Participants will be responsible for any other transportation need unless a special program is planned by the organizing committee.

Safety of Participants

Kigali is a very secure city and Rwanda National Police is committed to protecting and serving all visitors. However, like anywhere else, personal security is your responsibility within the conference premises and in Kigali as a whole.

Within the conference premises:

- Don't leave bags unattended
- Check your items before leaving meeting rooms
- If you lose any items, immediately alert Serena Security

Outside conference premises:

- In hotel rooms, safely keep away precious items and lock the door at all times. Deposit valuables at reception desk with a receipt.
- If you observe suspicious behavior, contact security
- Don't open unexpected packages delivered to you

Note that you will notice armed soldiers walk the streets of Kigali after dusk; this shouldn't cause alarm as they are night patrols charged with ensuring the city sleeps safe.

Feature on the Kigali Genocide Memorial Center located in Gisozi, Kigali

The memorial center was opened on the 10th anniversary of the Rwandan genocide against Tutsi which claimed the lives of 1 million Rwandans in 100 days. The center is a memorial to the 1 million innocent lives; a place to grieve for those who survived the massacres; and a reminder to the world to never let it happen again. The center is a burial home to over a quarter million of fallen Rwandans and has an exhibition of the Rwandan genocide as well as other genocides in the world.

In addition to the Kigali memorial center, other memorial sites not far from the city center include:
