

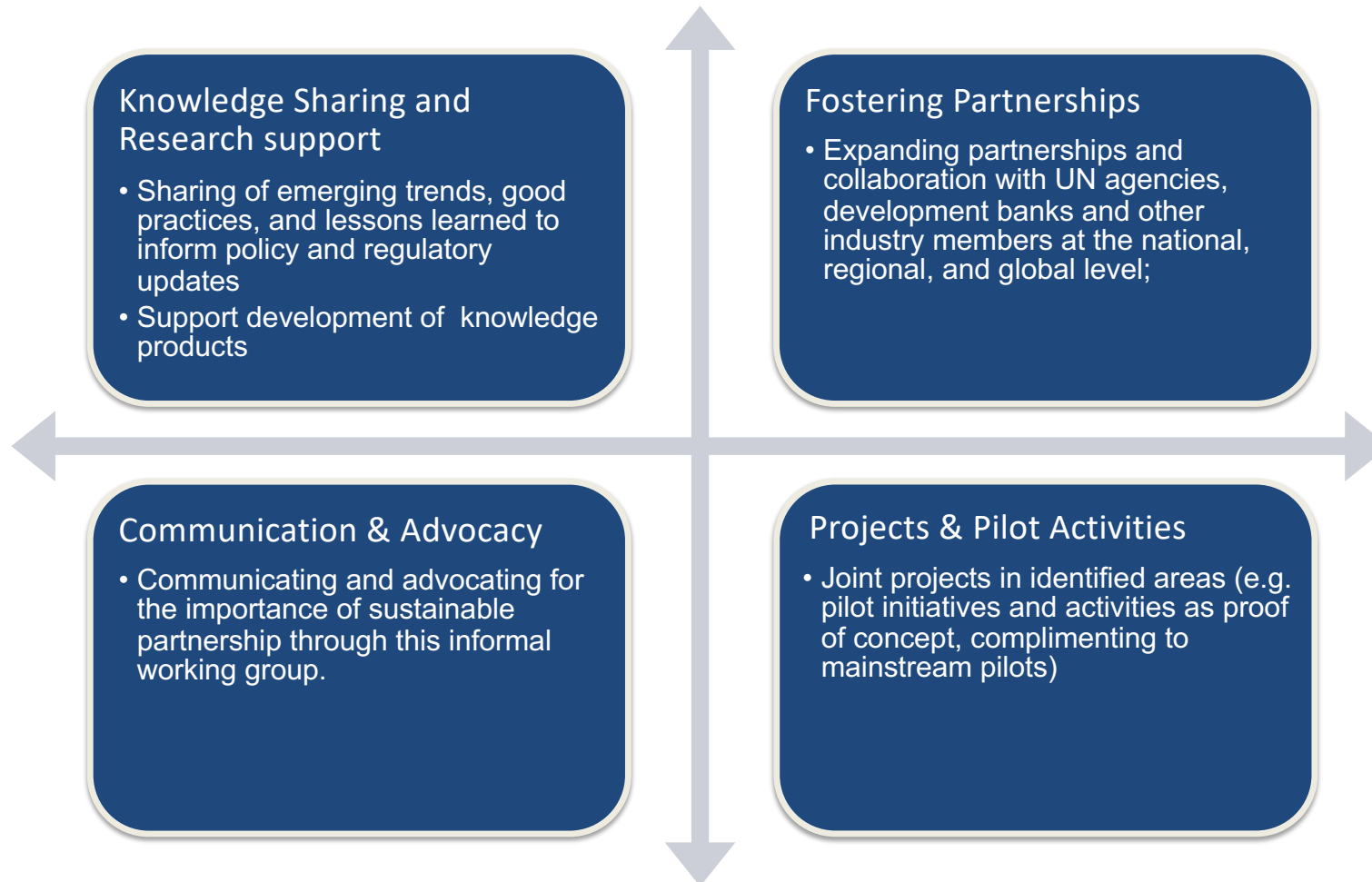

RP-ASP 1: Addressing special needs of least developed countries, small island developing states, including Pacific island countries, and landlocked developing countries

RP-ASP-3: Fostering development of infrastructure to enhance digital connectivity and connecting the unconnected

RP-ASP-4: Enabling policy and regulatory environments to accelerate digital transformation

RP-ASP-5: Contributing to a secure and resilient ICT environment

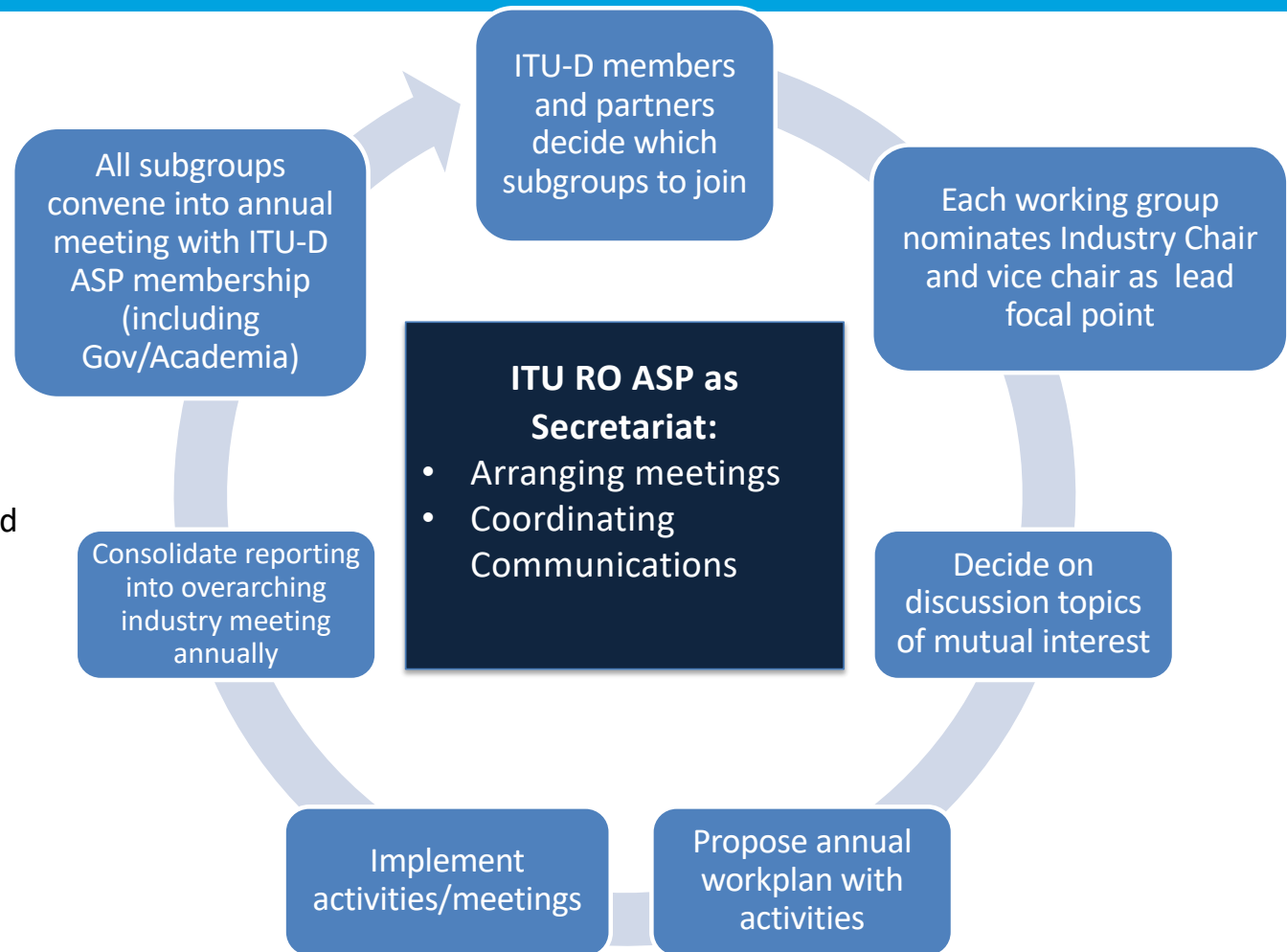
The RP-ASPs listed here are still provisional and are awaiting approval

- Joint research, publication of case studies, and working papers on emerging trends and policy recommendations;
- Projects and pilot initiatives;
- Advocacy via social media and other communications means.

 - Education
 - Sustainability and digital transformation (*including financing mechanisms*)
 - Resilience and distributed networks:
 - Cybersecurity (*Data Security/Privacy/Protection*)
 - Child Online Protection
