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# Challenges

- ▶ Identification of victims in the community is difficult because no one is willing to report.
- ▶ The Local Government lacks resources to support the rehabilitation of victims.
- ▶ Children and communities are not aware of the OSAEC Red Flags
- ▶ Emerging trends in sexual exploitation of children online including trends in language and lifestyles.
- ▶ Children and parents are not aware of the dangers online. “No touch no harm” misconception
- ▶ Children and Community members lack of capacity and knowledge on how to report - accessibility of reporting mechanism.
- ▶ Investigation of case are more offender focused.

# Opportunities

- ▶ Children themselves can identify victims of OSAEC.
- ▶ Empowered children can help in identifying cases of OSAEC since they are more immersed in the online world.



# Recommendations

- ▶ Reporting mechanisms should be established and strengthened.
- ▶ Children and Community Members should be educated about OSAEC red flags within their communities and the different reporting mechanisms.
- ▶ Focus and attention should be given in identifying and rehabilitating victims of OSAEC.
- ▶ Establishing CPQRT and CBHR.
