

IMPLEMENTATION of e-Learning Capabilities



2 Servers were purchased based on LAMP technology with high speed internet, a Juniper SSG5 firewall and Open Source technologies for the e-Learning Platform based on Joomla, Moodle and Joomdle, the same architecture that ITU Academy used since 2011
