Evolution of ICT Regulation

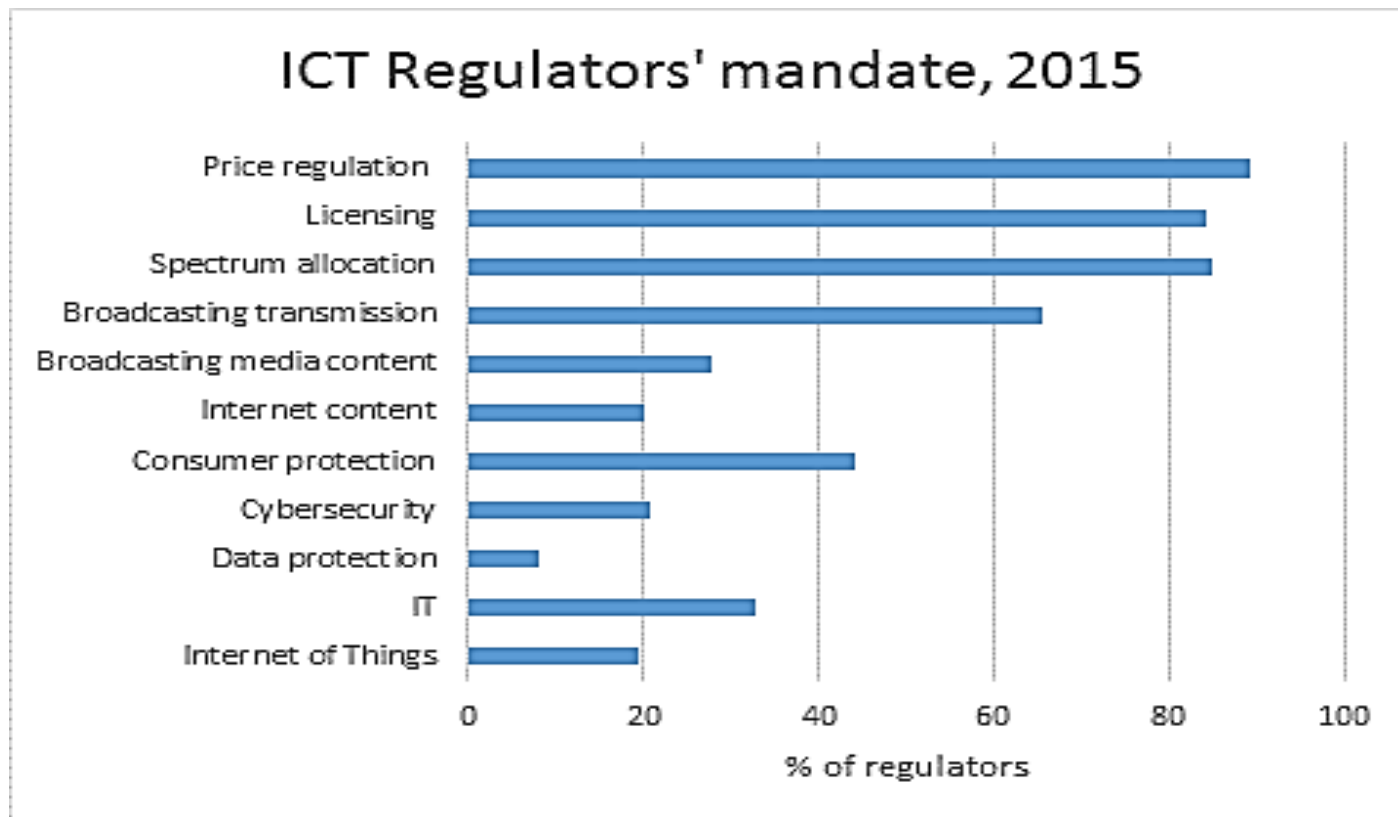

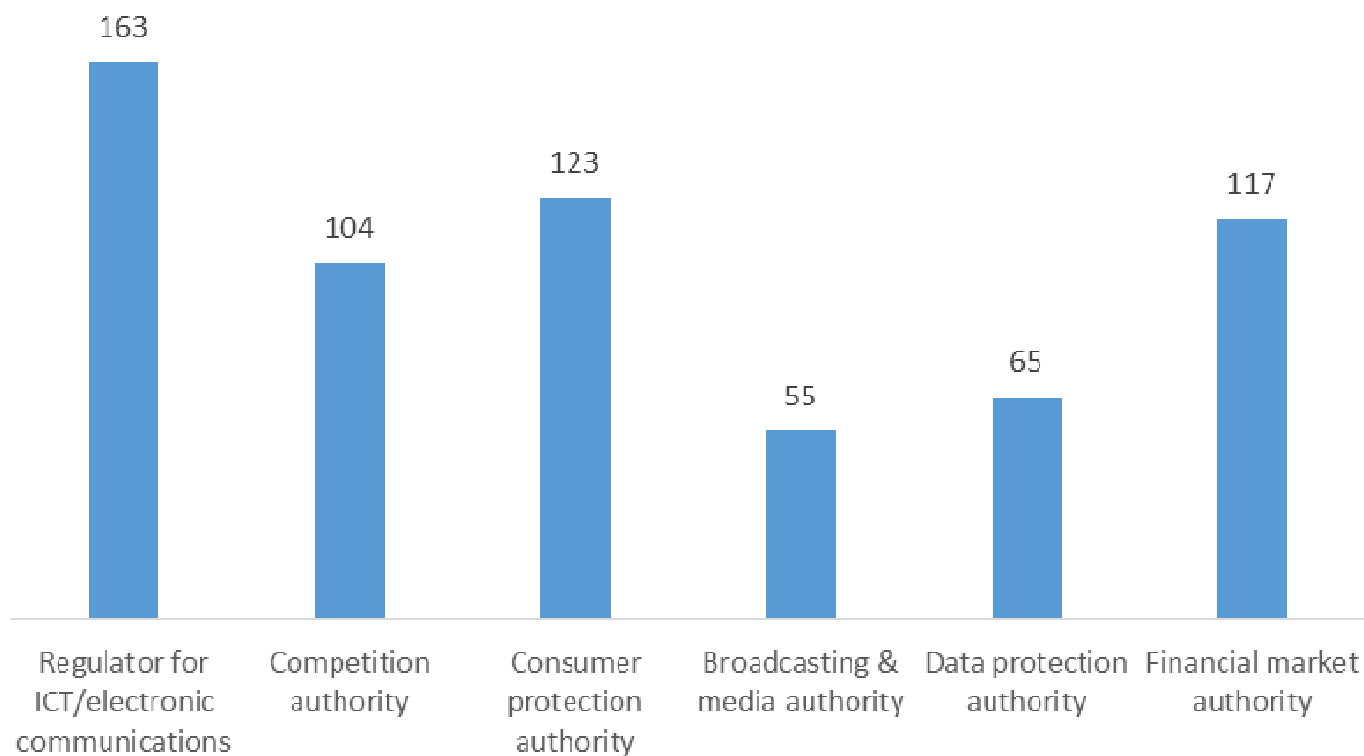

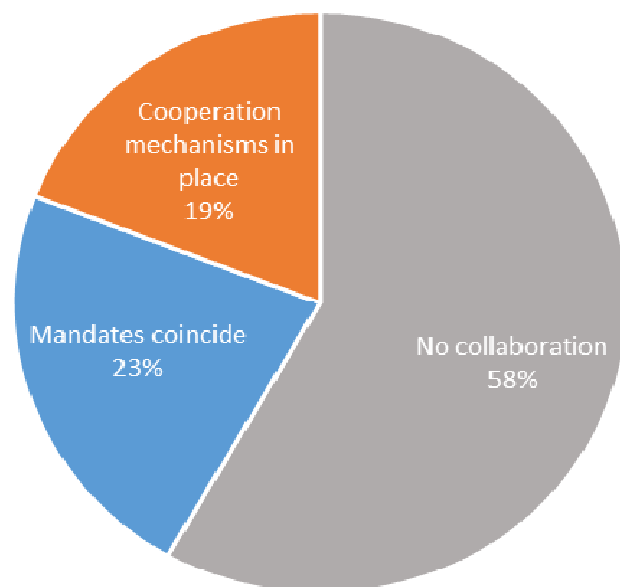
