## 2<sup>nd</sup> Meeting of the Expert Group on ICT Household Indicators (EGH) and Subject: 5<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Expert Group on Telecommunication/ICT Indicators (EGTI) 15-19 September 2014, Geneva, Switzerland

I am pleased to invite your organization to the 2014 meetings of the ITU expert groups on ICT indicators, which will be held in Geneva back to back. The 2<sup>nd</sup> Meeting of the Expert Group on ICT Household Indicators (EGH) will take place on 15-16 September 2014, and the 5<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the Expert Group on Telecommunication/ICT Indicators (EGTI) on 17-19 September 2014.

The objective of these meetings is to examine the contributions received from members of the EGTI and EGH online discussion forums over the current working period, with a view to finalizing the items under discussion. The outcome of the discussions will be presented at 12th World Telecommunication/ICT Indicators Symposium (WTIS), which will be held in Georgia on 24-26 November 2014.

The topics that will be covered during the EGH meeting include, among others: measuring mobile phone ownership and activities; Internet use by type of device; barriers to Internet use by individuals; Internet security; and child online protection.

The main topics that will be discussed during the EGTI meeting include, among others: the revision of broadband metrics; indicators on bundled telecommunication services; LTE and M2M indicators; and the revision of the list of indicators included in the ITU WTI Long Questionnaire.

The experience and expertise of your organization in the field of telecommunication/ICT indicators will greatly contribute to the success of these meetings. We therefore count on your presence and valuable inputs to the discussions.
