- How to draft resolutions,
- o Strategy, conflicts resolutions or negotiating aspects,
- o Radio Regulations and Rules of Procedure of the Space sector.

- o Delegations meeting to refine their contribution Lead by moderator/Facilitators
- o Plenary meeting to present the contributions of each delegations and create final resolution
- o Debriefing discussion, so that the people involved can learn from the experience
