Release of a new SpaceCap, BR-SIS Validation and SpacePub versions of software for capturing coordination agreement status with satellite networks of affected administrations

WRC-19 instructed the Bureau, when carrying out examination under RR No. **11.32A** to also take into account coordination agreement status with satellite networks of affected administrations at notice level when such information is provided for the notification of geostationary satellite networks, so that the notifying administration may benefit from the coordination agreements already obtained.

In this regard, WRC-19 introduced new data items A.5.a.1.a, A.5.a.2.a, A.6.a.1, A.6.b.1 in Annex 2 to Appendix 4 (as optional information). Such information will be published in PART-IS/IIS/IIIS of the BR IFIC.

SpaceCap has therefore been modified to provide a new interface that will allow administrations to select from a list of satellite networks, and indicate with which of these satellite networks coordination under No. **9.7** has been completed. This information will be taken into account by the Bureau when performing the examination under No. **11.32A**. Similarly, Administrations will now be able to indicate those satellite networks with which coordination under No. **9.13** or agreement under No. **9.21** has been obtained. However, this information will be published for information purposes only.

Other functionalities to support the submission of the list of satellite networks described above were also added to SpaceCap and e-Submission to indicate the type of resubmission requested by the notifying administration. BR-SIS Validation and SpacePub software were also modified accordingly.
