New user role in the e-Communications system to enable administrations to act on behalf of Intergovernmental satellite organizations

The Radiocommunication Bureau is pleased to announce the release of a new feature in the online communication platform “e-Communications” to allow administrations to act on behalf of an intergovernmental satellite organization (IGSO) by introducing a new user role “ADM/IGSO” on the system (“ADM” represents a code designating notifying administrations. “IGSO” represents a code of an intergovernmental satellite organization listed in Table 2 to the Preface to BR IFIC (Space Services)). This new feature is available as from 01.09.2022.

The new user role “ADM/IGSO” enables an administration acting on behalf of an IGSO to send and receive correspondence with the other administrations, including other ADM/IGSO, and the Bureau. The “ADM/IGSO” account can be obtained by administrations which can act as a notifying administration of IGSO.
